Iowa Home Visiting Service & Demographics Report

Purpose of this report

This report provides data on services and aggregate participant data (i.e. demographics) for data in the Iowa Home Visiting DAISEY module. The tables in this report were determined by reporting requirements of the Iowa Home Visiting funder, Iowa Health and Human Services (IHHS), and are in alignment with MIECHV data reporting requirements.

What this report represents

Data from Primary Caregiver and Target Child profiles, Home Visit Review Form, and Enrollment & Annual Reports for the Primary Caregiver and Target Child will be reflected in this report. Forms completed in the current fiscal year will be reviewed for responses. Where there is not yet data for the current fiscal year, data from the previous fiscal year will be used. If any forms are missing from both the current and previous fiscal year, the data taken from these forms will be considered “Unknown/Did not report”.

Basic Navigation: Using Filters

Use the following filters to determine the data to review:

Select Reporting Year, Select Reporting Period, Grantee, Organization, County, Home Visiting Model, and Home Visit Type. Grantee, Organization, County, Home Visiting Model, and Home Visit Type parameters are multi-select (Figure 1); reports will show all data for all selected choices (Figure 2).
