<i>Benchmark 1: Maternal and Newborn Health</i>	
Construct	<i>Measure 1: Preterm Birth</i>
Systems Outcome	% of infants (among mothers who enrolled prenatally before 37 weeks) who are born preterm following program enrollment
Construct	<i>Measure 2: Breastfeeding</i>
Systems Outcome	% of infants (among mothers who enrolled prenatally) who were breastfed any amount at 6 months of age
Construct	<i>Measure 3: Depression Screening</i>
Performance Indicator	% of primary caregivers screened for depression within 3 months of enrollment (if not enrolled prenatally) or within 3 months of delivery (if enrolled prenatally)
Construct	<i>Measure 4: Well Child Visit</i>
Performance Indicator	% of children who received the last recommended visit based on the American Academy of Pediatrics schedule
Construct	<i>Measure 5: Postpartum Care</i>
Performance Indicator	% of mothers enrolled prenatally or within 30 days after delivery who received a postpartum visit with a healthcare provider within 8 weeks of delivery
Construct	<i>Measure 6: Tobacco Cessation Referrals</i>
Performance Indicator	% of primary caregivers who reported using tobacco at enrollment and were referred to tobacco cessation counseling/services within 3 months of enrollment
<i>Benchmark 2: Child Injuries, Abuse, Neglect and Maltreatment and Emergency Department Visits</i>	
Construct	<i>Measure 7: Safe Sleep</i>
Performance Indicator	% of infants that are always placed to sleep on their backs, without bed-sharing or soft bedding
Construct	<i>Measure 8: Child Injury</i>
Systems Outcome	Rate of injury-related visits to the Emergency Department since enrollment among children enrolled in home visiting
Construct	<i>Measure 9: Child Maltreatment</i>
Systems Outcome	% of children with at least 1 investigated case of maltreatment following enrollment within the reporting period
<i>Benchmark 3: School Readiness and Achievement</i>	
Construct	<i>Measure 10: Parent-Child Interaction</i>
Performance Indicator	% of primary caregivers who receive an observation of caregiver-child interaction by the home visitor using a validated tool
Construct	<i>Measure 11: Early Language and Literacy Activities</i>
Performance Indicator	% of children with a family member who reported that during a typical week s/he read, told stories, and/or sang songs with their child every day
Construct	<i>Measure 12: Developmental Screening</i>
Performance Indicator	% of children with a timely screen for developmental delays using a validated parent-completed tool
Construct	<i>Measure 13: Behavioral Concerns</i>
Performance Indicator	% of home visits where primary caregivers were asked if they have any concerns regarding their child's development, behavior, or learning
<i>Benchmark 4: Domestic Violence</i>	
Construct	<i>Measure 14: Intimate Partner Violence Screening</i>
Performance Indicator	% of primary caregivers who are screened for interpersonal violence within 6 months of enrollment using a validated tool

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<i>Benchmark 5: Family Economic Self-Sufficiency</i>	
Construct	Measure 15: Primary Caregiver Education
Systems Outcome	% of primary caregivers without a HS degree or equivalent who subsequently enrolled in, maintained continuous enrollment in, or completed HS or equivalent
Construct	Measure 16: Continuity of Insurance Coverage
Systems Outcome	% of primary caregivers who had continuous health insurance coverage for at least 6 consecutive months
<i>Benchmark 6: Coordination and Referrals for Other Community Resources and Supports</i>	
Construct	Measure 17: Completed Depression Referrals
Systems Outcome	% of primary caregivers referred to services for a positive screen for depression who receive one or more service contacts
Construct	Measure 18: Completed Developmental Referrals
Systems Outcome	% of children with positive screens for developmental delays (measured using a validated tool) who receive services in a timely manner
Construct	Measure 19: Intimate Partner Violence Referrals
Performance Indicator	% of primary caregivers with positive screens for intimate partner violence (IPV) who receive referral information to IPV resources
