



Iowa MIECHV DAISEY Technical Assistance Brief Form 2 Report Guide



PURPOSE OF THIS REPORT

This report provides data on how Iowa MIECHV programs perform using the benchmarks established by the Health Resource and Services Administration (HRSA), the funder for the MIECHV program. Each dashboard provides a visual that lists the benchmark construct, who is considered for that benchmark, and a performance bar.

WHAT THIS REPORT REPRESENTS

USING FILTERS

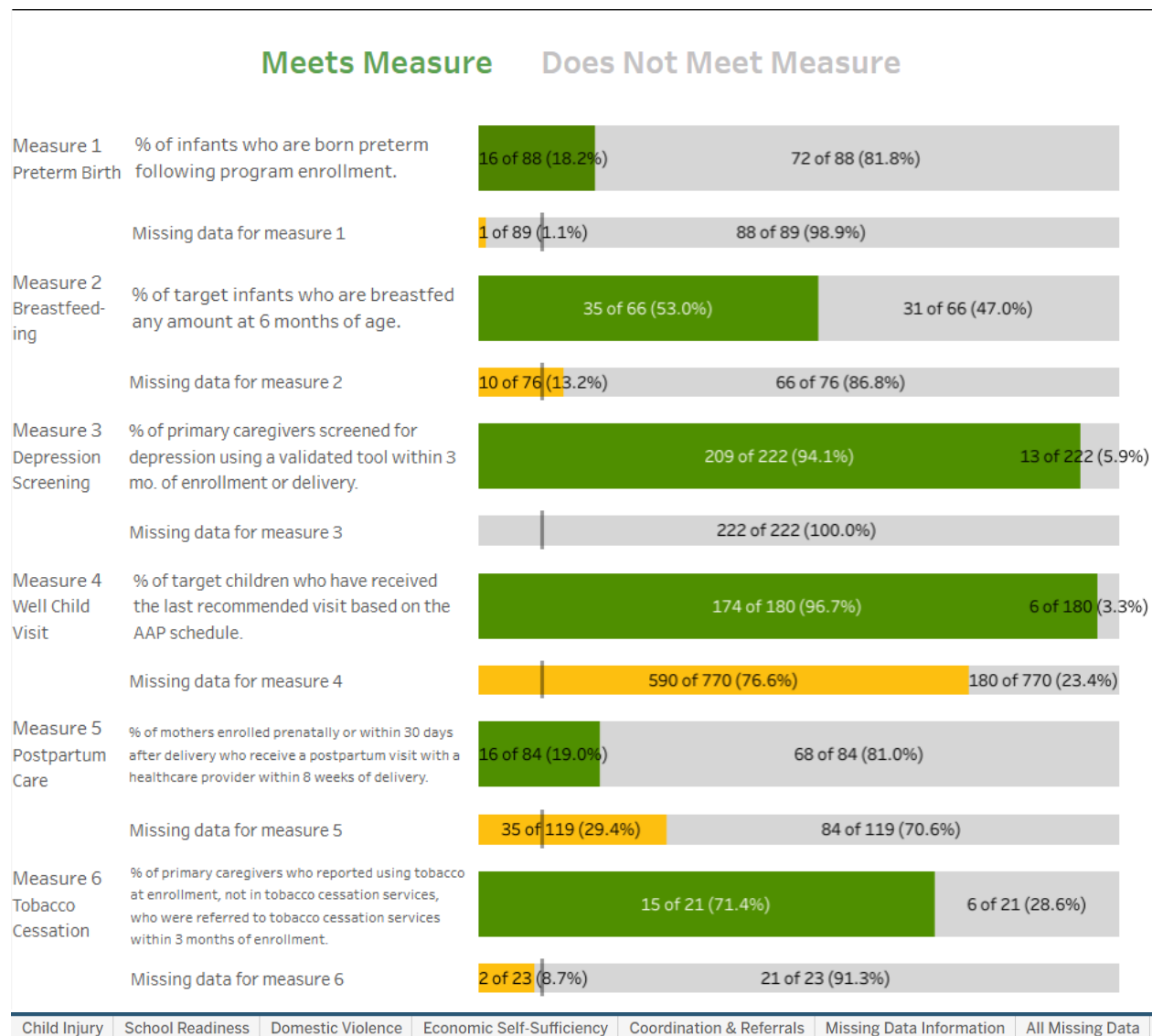
*Reports will only display if the correct Grantee – Organization is selected and matches the user's access in DAISEY.

ANNUAL REPORT DATA SOURCE- IMPORTANT NOTE

Please note that all benchmark constructs that utilize Primary Caregiver or Target Child Annual Reports will show a high proportion of “does not meet measure” until all annual reports are completed for that year (by Oct. 15 of the following fiscal year). This includes the following constructs: 4 (well-child visit), 5 (postpartum care), 11 (early language and literacy), 15 (primary caregiver education), and 16 (continuity of insurance coverage).

REVIEWING DATA

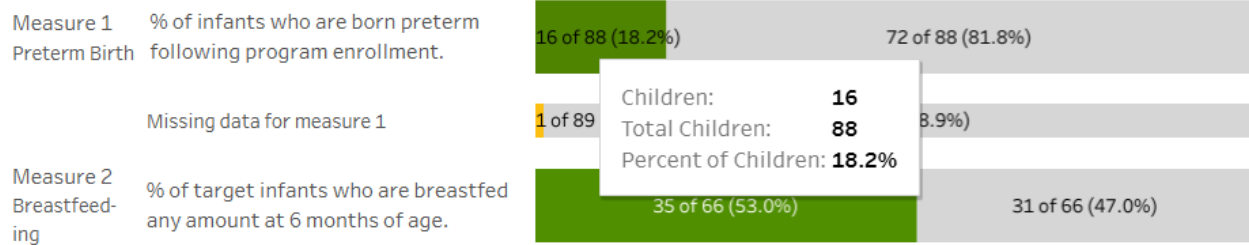
To determine the clients included in a bar, click on a section of the bar and the list on the right will reflect Primary Caregivers and Children included in that count. Click a section of the bar to determine those included in the count; click the bar a second time to remove the filter to reset the list to include all clients.



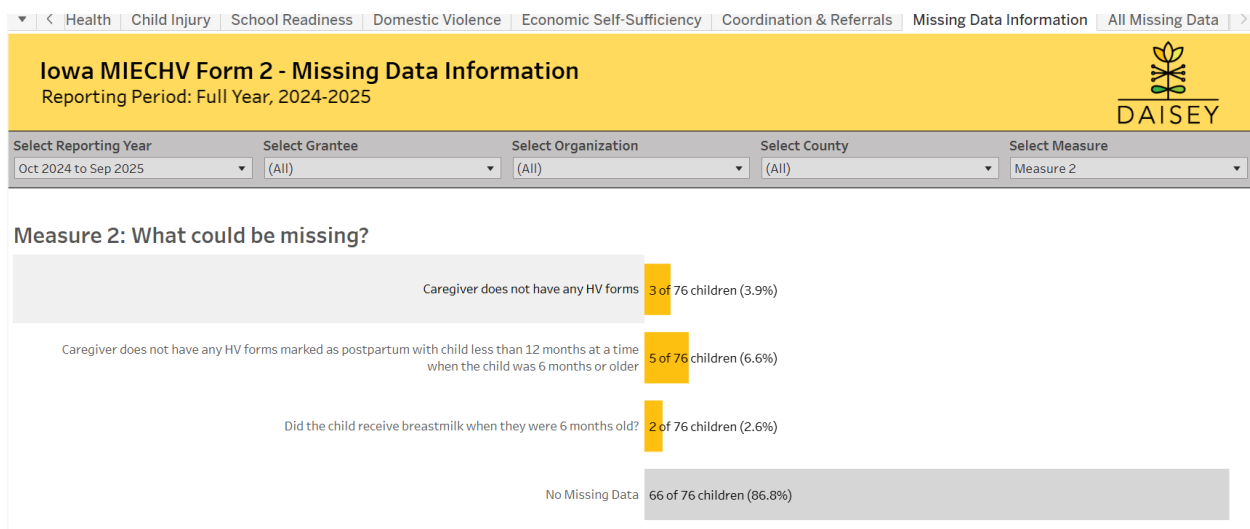

In this report, the **green** section of the bars represents clients who meet numerator criteria for the measure. The **gray** section of the bar represents clients that are counted in the denominator but **do not** meet the requirements of the numerator. To determine the number of caregivers/children in each bar, simply hover over that bar:

To review why a child or caregiver might be appearing in the Missing category, the Missing Data Information dashboard allows users to filter to a specific measure and see why the child or caregiver might be included in the missing category.

Measure 1: Preterm Birth	Child Profile	Of target children, those born before 37 weeks are included in the numerator and children born at or after 37 weeks are included in the denominator.	"Was the family enrolled prenatally?", "Was the child born at less than 37 weeks?"
Measure 2: Breastfeeding	Home Visit Review Form	Of target children who were enrolled prenatally and are at least 6 months of age during the reporting period, those that were	"Was this a prenatal or postpartum home visit?", "Was the child given breast milk until at least 6 months old?"

		breastfed until at least 6 months are included in the numerator.	
Measure 3: Depression Screening	EPDS Screener, Child Profile	Of primary caregivers, those who received an EPDS screening on or between the target child's date of birth and the caregiver's 3-month postpartum date are included in the numerator. NOTE: Any EPDS completed before the caregiver gives birth will be excluded from this criterion.	Date of activity from EPDS screener, target child date of birth from child profile.
Measure 4: Well-Child Visit	Enrollment and Annual Report - Target Child	Of target children, those up-to-date on well child exams are included in the numerator and those not up to date on well child exams are included in the denominator.	"Is the child up-to-date on well child exams?"
Measure 5: Postpartum Care	Enrollment and Annual Report - Primary Caregiver	Of primary caregivers, those who reached 8-weeks postpartum in the reporting period and who received a postpartum medical visit are included in the numerator.	"Did mom reach 8 weeks postpartum in this reporting period?", "Did mom receive a postpartum medical visit within 8 weeks of delivery?",
Measure 6: Tobacco Cessation Referrals	Enrollment EAR - Primary Caregiver	Primary caregivers enrolled in home visiting who reported using tobacco or cigarettes at enrollment and who were referred to tobacco cessation counseling or services within 3 months of enrollment will be counted in the numerator.	"Is the primary caregiver using tobacco in the home?", "At enrollment, was this person receiving tobacco cessation services?", "Was a tobacco cessation referral given?", "Date of tobacco cessation referral"
Measure 7: Safe Sleep	Home Visit Review Form	Target children whose primary caregiver reports that they are always placed to sleep on their backs, without bed-sharing and without soft bedding are included in the numerator. NOTE: The response on the most recent Home Visit Review Form withing the selected date range will determine numerator eligibility.	"Is this a postpartum home visit?", "Was the infant always placed to sleep on his/her back, without bed sharing or soft bedding?"

Measure 8: Child Injury	Home Visit Review Form	Those with a ER visits > 0 are counted in the numerator. Those with visits = 0 are counted in the denominator.	"Is this a postpartum home visit?", "# of parent-reported nonfatal injury-related visits to the ER since last visit"
Measure 9: Child Maltreatment		Not included in Form 2, but captured and reported outside of DAISEY.	
Measure 10: Parent-Child Interaction	Iowa Parent Child Interaction Form	Primary caregivers who have had a PCI form completed in the reporting period are counted in the numerator.	Date of activity from PCI screener
Measure 11: Early Language and Literacy Activities	Enrollment and Annual Report - Target Child	Primary caregivers who report reading, telling stories, or singing songs to the child every day in a typical week are included in the numerator.	"During a typical week, does a family member read, tell stories, or sing songs to the child every day?"
Measure 12: Developmental Screening	ASQ-3 Form	Of index children aged 9-30 months, those who have had an age appropriate ASQ-3 screener in the reporting period are in the numerator.	Date of activity from ASQ-3 screener
Measure 13: Behavioral Concerns	Home Visit Review Form	Number of postnatal home visits where primary caregivers enrolled in home visiting were asked if they have any concerns regarding their child's development, behavior, or learning is counted in the numerator.	"During this home visit, was the caregiver asked if they have any concerns regarding their child's development, behavior, or learning?"
Measure 14: Intimate Partner Violence Screening	Relationship Assessment Tool	Primary caregivers enrolled in home visiting who are screened for IPV using a validated tool within 6 months of enrollment are included in the numerator.	Date of activity from IPV screener
Measure 15: Primary Caregiver Education	Enrollment and Annual Report - Primary Caregiver	Primary caregivers who enrolled in or maintained continuous enrollment in middle school or high school, or completed a high school degree or equivalent after enrollment in home visiting are included in the numerator.	Education level, Education Status and Type of Educational Program (Middle or high school GED program).
Measure 16: Continuity of Insurance Coverage	Enrollment and Annual Report - Primary Caregiver	Primary caregivers enrolled in home visiting	"Did the primary caregiver have continuous health

		who reported having continuous health insurance coverage for the most recent 6 consecutive months at the most recent data collection time point in the reporting period are included in the numerator.	insurance coverage for the past six months?"
Measure 17: Completed Depression Referrals	EPDS Screener	Primary caregivers enrolled in home visiting who received a positive depression screening and received recommended services for depression are included in the numerator.	"Referral given?", "What type of referral was made?", "Was referral completed?"
Measure 18: Developmental Referrals	ASQ-3 Form	Target children with an ASQ-3 9,18, or 30 month positive screen and who were referred to services are included in the numerator.	ASQ-3 positive screening score, "Follow up action taken:"
Measure 19: Intimate Partner Violence Referrals	Relationship Assessment Tool	Primary caregivers who are screened for IPV using a validated tool within 6 months of enrollment, and who receive a positive screening score resulting in referral to services are included in the numerator.	RAT positive screening score, "What referrals and information were given to the client this session?"
