

Welcome! We're glad you've made it here - This tool is designed to enable you to monitor your organizations benchmark performance.

Please begin by opening the **Benchmark Measure (Form 2)** report in DAISEY and select the appropriate **reporting year**. From here, note the completion percentage (green bar) for each measure in the "My org status" column below.

To determine improvement, HRSA is defining "improvement" as meeting one or both of the following criteria: 1 – any change in the intended direction for that measure, compared to the baseline, 2 – meeting or exceeding the established threshold for a measure, while simultaneously not decreasing performance from baseline by more than 10%.
