



Kansas MIECHV Report Guide

Missing Data Report



PURPOSE OF REPORT: This report will assist home visitors, supervisors, and state leads with identifying missing or incorrect data to ensure a complete and correct dataset is represented.

Reminder: Primary caregivers and children with profiles and activities entered into DAISEY will be represented in reports. The data only reflects families that are enrolled during the date range selected in the filter and have a completed enrollment/discharge form.

What does this report represent

This report represents data entered into DAISEY for Kansas MIECHV programs. All dashboards will provide information on *Missing* and *Complete* data; some graphs may have *Unknown* or *Invalid* data. To further explore the *Unknown* or *Invalid* data, it will be necessary to view the underlying data (refer to the [Accessing Underlying Client-Level Data guide](#)). DAISEY reports update on a nightly basis. Data entered into DAISEY will be available in reports the next day.

Report Parameters

Reports can be filtered by Reporting Year, Organization, Program Model, County, and Home Visitor Name, which can be selected in a drop-down menu.

CAREGIVER PROFILE AND ENROLLMENT FORM MISSING DATA

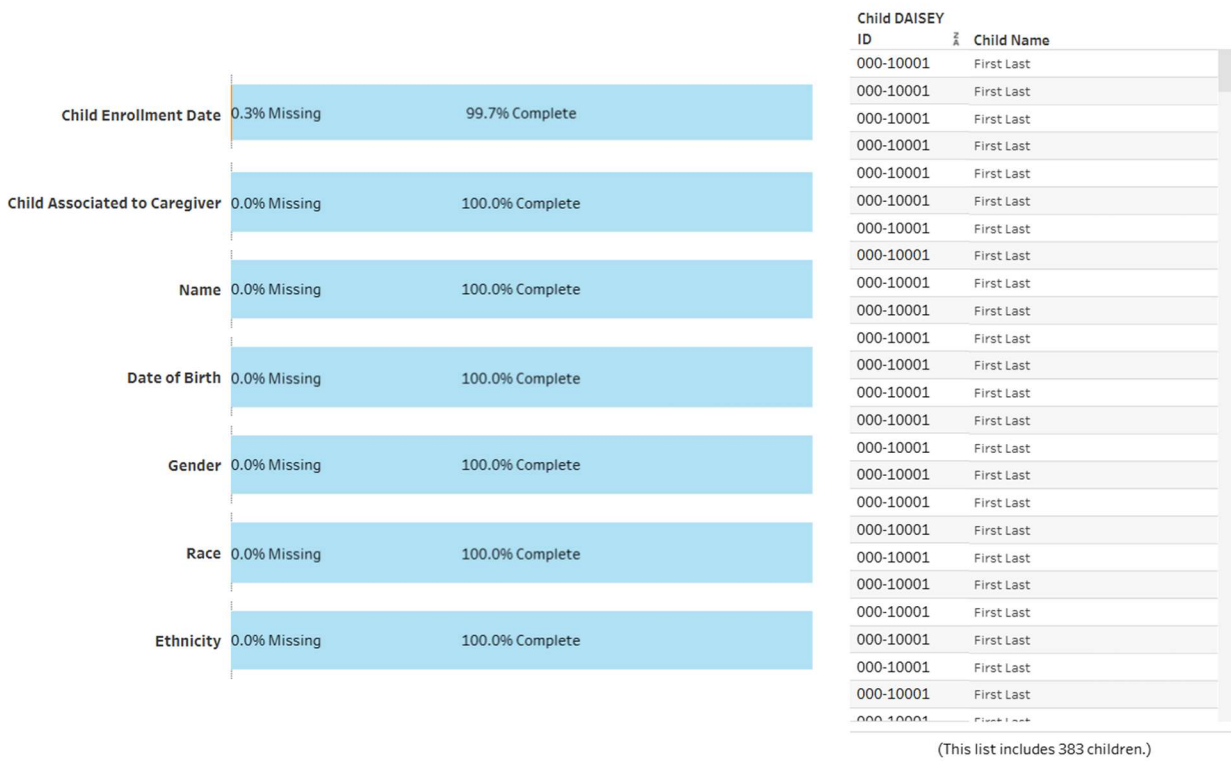


Questions considered: First Name, Last Name, Date of Birth, Is this the primary caregiver of the child?, Caregiver Gender, Caregiver Race, Caregiver Ethnicity, Date of Enrollment, Date of Discharge, Pregnancy Status at Enrollment, Estimated Due Date (if “Pregnant” is selected for pregnancy status at enrollment), Did pregnancy result in a live birth (if “Pregnant” is selected for pregnancy status at enrollment).

Form: Child Profile and Child Enrollment Form.

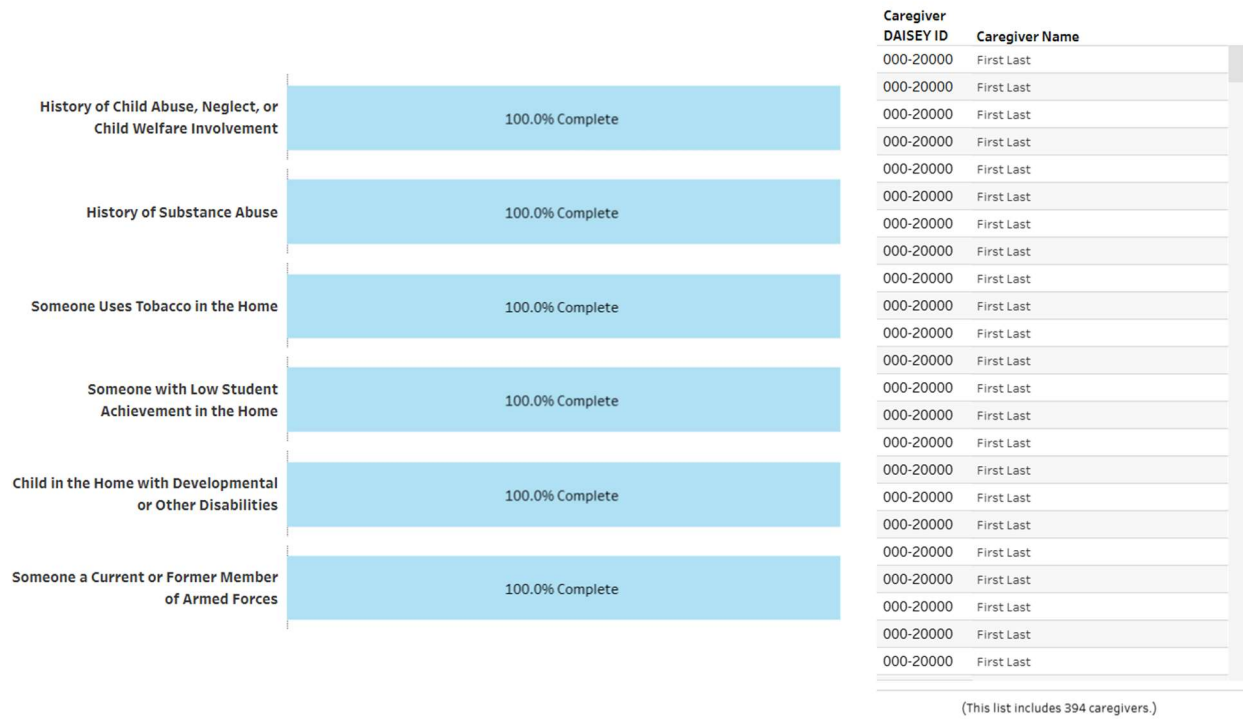
Questions considered: First Name, Last Name, Date of Birth, Child Gender, Child Race, Child Ethnicity, Primary Caregiver Date of Enrollment, and Primary Caregiver Date of Discharge

Who is counted: All children whose primary caregiver is enrolled anytime during the date range selected.

Form: Caregiver Demographics Form

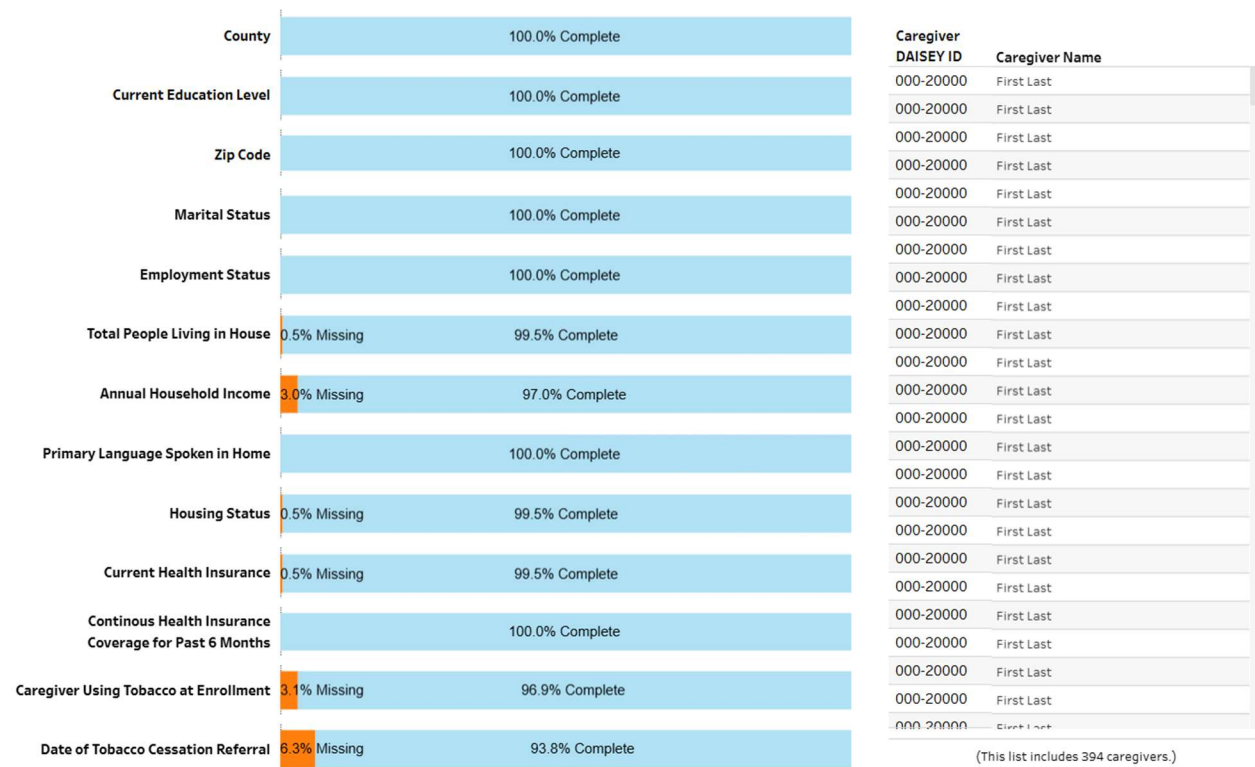
Questions considered: Primary Caregiver Enrollment Date and Date of Discharge, History of Child Abuse, Neglect, or Child Welfare Involvement, History of Substance Abuse, Someone Uses Tobacco in the Home, Someone with Low student Achievement in the Home, Child in the Home with Development or Other Disabilities, and Someone in household currently serving or formerly served in the US Armed Forces.

Who is counted: All Primary Caregivers who are enrolled anytime during the date range selected.

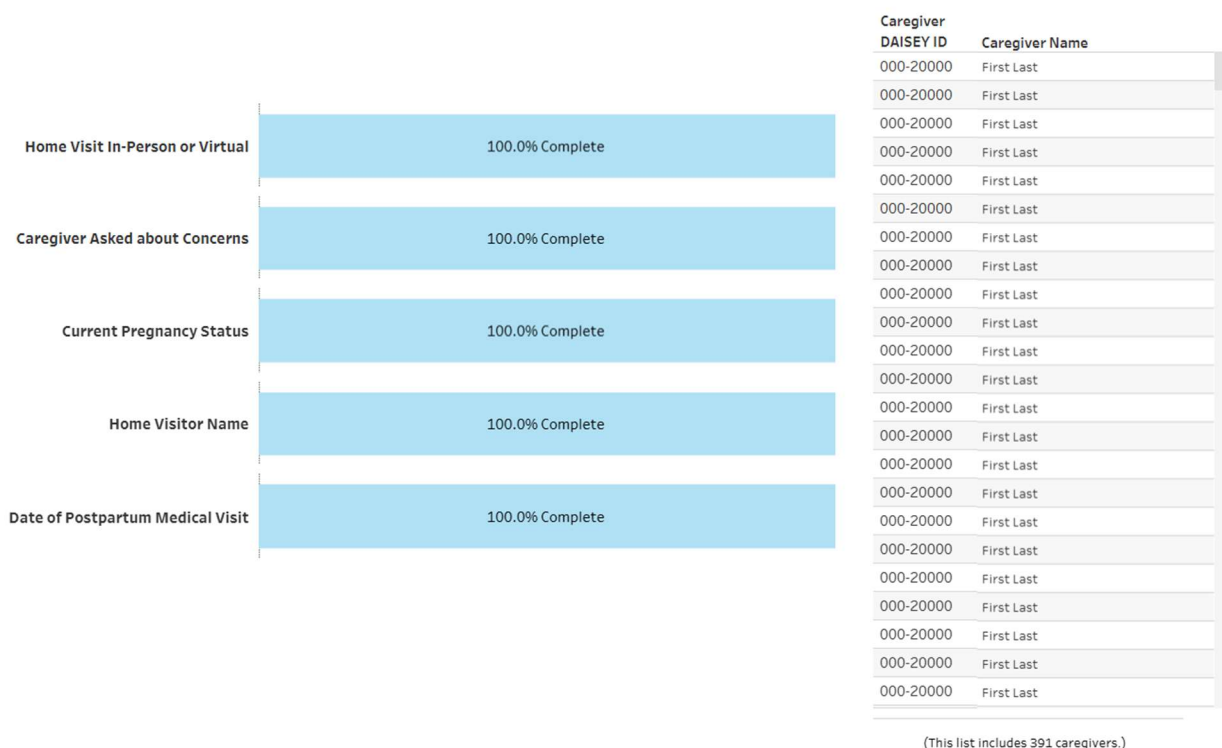
Questions considered: Enrollment Date, Discharge Date, County, Current Education Level, Zip Code, Marital Status, Employment Status, Total People Living in House, Annual Household Income, Primary Language Spoken in Home, Housing Status, Current Health Insurance, Continuous Health Insurance Coverage for Past 6 Months, Caregiver Using Tobacco at Enrollment, and Date of Tobacco Cessation Referral.

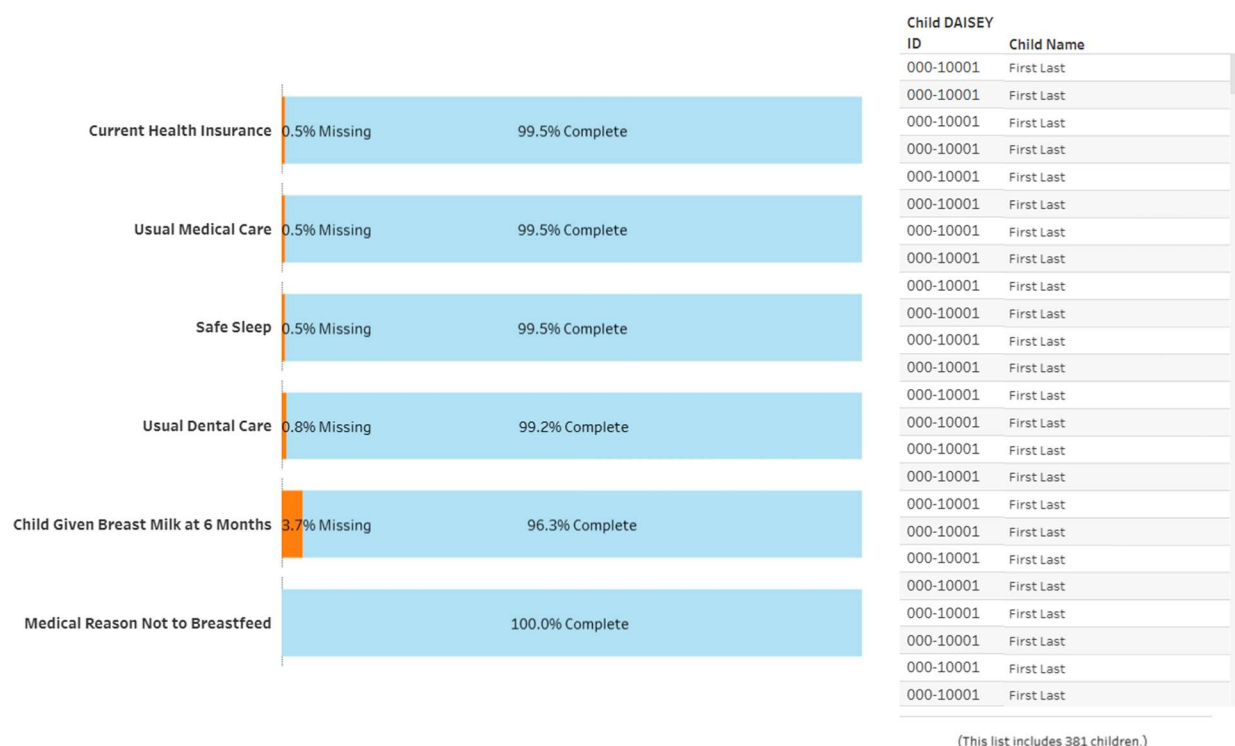
Details

Form: Caregiver Home Visiting Form

Questions considered: Home Visit In-Person or Virtual, Caregiver Asked about Behavioral Concerns, Current Pregnancy Status, Home Visitor Name, and Date of Postpartum Medical Visit.

Who is counted: All Primary Caregivers enrolled anytime during the date range selected.

Form: Child Demographics Form

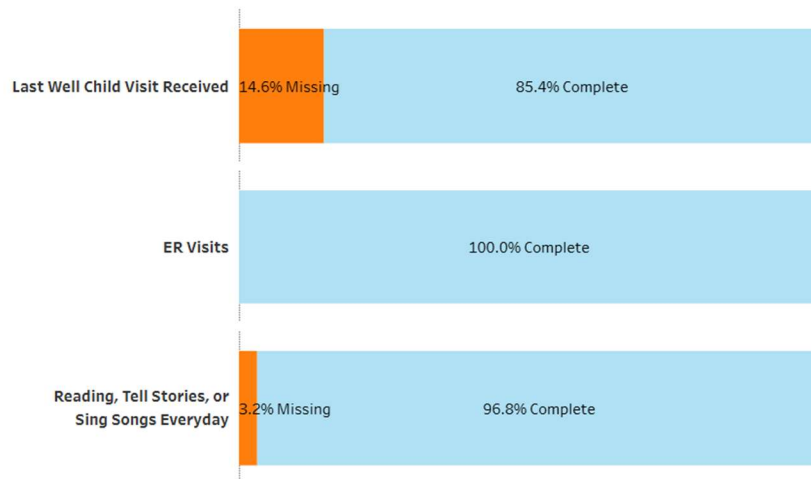
Questions considered: Current health insurance, What is the child's usual source of medical care?, Safe sleep: Is/was the infant always placed to sleep on their back, without bed sharing or soft bedding through 12months of age?, Does this child have a usual source of dental care?, Did the child receive any amount of breast milk at age 6 months?, and Medical Reason not to Breastfeed.

Who is counted: All children whose primary caregiver is enrolled anytime during the date range selected.

Details

Form: Child Activities Form

Questions considered: Did the child receive the last recommended well-child visit based on the child's current age?, Number of child ER visits due to injury, and During a typical week, does a family member read, tell stories, or sing songs to the child every day?.

Who is counted: All children whose primary caregiver is enrolled anytime during the date range selected.
