



WIHV Report Guide:

WIHV Federal Demographics Report



This guide provides some background information and additional program instructions for users accessing the WIHV Federal Demographics Report.

Report purpose:

The WIHV Federal Demographics Report provides the client demographic information required for the State's annual federal Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting Program (MIECHV) data report.

Who is counted:

Active Participants: The WIHV Federal Demographics report counts participants who are actively enrolled in the selected date range. This is defined as a participant whose most recent discharge date (without a subsequent enrollment date) falls after the user-selected Start Date. Participants with an enrollment date on or before the user-selected end date who do not have a recorded discharge date are also counted as active.

New vs Continuing Program Participants: New participants are active participants whose most recent enrollment date is on or after the user-selected Start Date. Continuing Participants are active participants whose most recent enrollment date is before the user-selected Start Date.

Pregnant Women: Actively enrolled female caregivers are counted as Pregnant Women if they meet either of the following two conditions for their most recent enrollment:

1. They indicate that they are pregnant at enrollment AND if the child was born, it occurred after the caregiver's enrollment date and the user-selected Start Date.
2. Their associated child has a Date of Birth that falls within the user-selected Start and End Date and after the caregiver's enrollment date.

Filters used in this report:

The date filters will display data for active participants within the selected dates. Users may also filter their data by Grantee, Organization, Enrollment Type, Home Visiting Model, and County.
